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9	Section 1. W.S. 42-4-120 by creating a new subsection
10	(f) is amended to read:
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12	42-4-120. Contracts for waiver services; authority of
13	department; emergency case services.

1 (f) The department, not later than October 1, 2007, 2 shall promulgate rules under which an emergency waiver case 3 shall be determined to exist with respect to eligibility 4 for federal home and community based waiver services under 5 this act. Upon a finding by the department that an emergency exists under this subsection, the department in 6 7 accordance with its rules and regulations shall make necessary expenditures for the recipient from the emergency 8 9 contingency account established for that purpose. 10 Expenditures from the emergency contingency account shall 11 be limited to those services necessary to provide 12 authorized waiver services in response to the emergency 13 situation until the emergency no longer exists or 14 eligibility under this act can be determined and any necessary services provided from non-emergency funding 15 16 sources.

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Section 2. (a) For the purposes of this act, there is 19 appropriated to the department of health for the period 20 commencing July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008:

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22 (i) Four hundred seventy two-thousand eight 23 hundred dollars (\$472,800.00) from the general fund; and

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(ii) Five hundred twenty seven thousand two 1 2 hundred dollars (\$527,200.00) in federal funds. 3 4 (b) Funds appropriated under this section shall be 5 used only for the purposes of this act, shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and shall not 6 be expended until the adoption of final rules as provided 7 in section 1 of this act. Any unexpended, unobligated 8 9 funds remaining from this appropriation on June 30, 2008 10 shall revert to the budget reserve account. 11 12 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2007. 13
