A BILL

- 2 regarding students attending multiple institutions under
- 3 the Hathaway scholarship program; and providing for an

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1308(a)(iv), (v) and (c)(intro)
- 9 is amended to read:

11 21-16-1308. Administration; rules and regulations.

- 13 (a) This article shall be administered by the
- 14 department in accordance with the following:

- 16 (iv) Each eligible institution receiving an
- 17 application from a student applying for a Hathaway

1 scholarship shall preliminarily determine the student's 2 eligibility for the scholarship. For students initially 3 applying for a scholarship, unless the student's complete 4 academic record is available, the GPA used to preliminarily 5 determine eligibility shall be based upon the student's official high school transcript after either the end of the 6 7 first semester of a student's senior year or the second semester of a student's junior year, at the sole discretion 8 9 of the eligible institution. For students graduating prior 10 their senior year the GPA used to preliminarily 11 determine eligibility shall be based upon the student's 12 official high school transcript as of the end of the 13 semester immediately prior to the last semester before the 14 student's graduation. High school GPAs for eligibility determinations for students initially applying 15 16 for a scholarship under this article shall be based upon 17 the student's complete high school academic record. Upon final determination of scholarship eligibility, each 18 community college shall certify to the community college 19 20 commission not later than thirty (30) days after the 21 semester commences, a list of students enrolled at the 22 institution who qualify for a scholarship under this article, including the amount of each scholarship. 23 24 university shall certify to the department within forty-

1 five (45) days after the semester commences a like list for 2 students enrolled at the university. The director of the 3 community college commission shall verify within ten (10) 4 days after receiving all lists from community colleges that 5 whether there is no any duplication of students on the community college lists, shall provide the lists to the 6 department and shall certify to the department the amount 7 each college is to receive under this article. Students 8 9 attending more than one (1) eligible institution shall 10 enter into a consortium agreement with the multiple institutions whereby the student shall designate a home 11

institution to be paid the entire Hathaway scholarship

amount for which the student qualifies;

15 (v) The department shall determine and certify 16 to the state treasurer the amount which is equal to 17 seventy-five percent (75%) of the total amount the eligible institution received during the preceding semester under 18 this subsection. Not later than September 1 for the fall 19 20 semester and not later than January 15 for the spring 21 semester, the state treasurer shall pay from the 22 scholarship expenditure account the amount certified by the department. The department shall review the lists provided 23 24 under paragraph (iv) of this subsection, determine whether

1 there is no any duplication of students, and determine and certify to the state treasurer the balance of the amount 2 3 due under this article to each institution for the semester. 4 For any duplication, the department shall 5 determine whether the student is attending more than one (1) eligible institution. If the student is attending 6 7 multiple eligible institutions payment of the Hathaway scholarship for which the student qualifies shall be made 8 9 only to the institution designated as the home institution 10 by the student. The state treasurer shall pay from the scholarship expenditure account the balance of the amount 11 12 Payments of the balance due under this paragraph due. 13 shall be made not later than seventy-five (75) days after the institution's semester has commenced. Payments to the 14 university shall be made directly to the university. 15 Payments to the community colleges shall be made directly 16 17 to each college and be reported by the state treasurer to the community college commission. Should a prepayment 18 19 under this paragraph exceed the amount actually due the 20 institution for any semester, the excess amount shall be 21 calculated by the department and deducted from the next 22 payment made. For purposes of this subsection, payments included within the 23 due for summer terms shall be 24 calculations and payments for the subsequent fall semester.

2 (c) The department shall establish annual reporting 3 procedures for purposes of policy analysis and program 4 evaluation and providing accurate data to the legislature 5 and governor relative to the program's impact on the state students. In developing the annual reporting 6 and on 7 procedure the department shall consult with the University of Wyoming and community college financial aid officers and 8 9 registrars or their designees. It is the intention of the 10 legislature that the reporting system and the requirements 11 thereof shall be applicable to all recipients 12 scholarships under this article. Compliance with this made a condition of 13 section shall be receiving a scholarship under this article. For any student attending 14 15 more than one (1) eligible institution, the home 16 institution shall be responsible for data reporting for 17 that student, and any other eligible institution shall cooperate as necessary with the home institution to fulfill 18 19 that duty. The reporting system shall include the following 20 information:

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
