## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to school finance; continuing funding for
- 2 the summer school-extended day programs during school year
- 3 2007-2008; modifying summer school program requirements;
- 4 clarifying the enrichment program component; imposing
- 5 reporting requirements; and providing for an effective

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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2 The summer school grant program is established (a) 3 for the 2006 and 2007 summer sessions to provide 4 financial assistance to districts for the provision of 5 intervention, remediation and enrichment instruction to students beyond the required school year specified by law 6 7 under W.S. 21-4-301 and 21-13-307 (a) (ii). The grant program shall augment amounts within the education resource 8 9 block grant model for addressing at-risk student needs over 10 a transitional period during which full cost-based funding 11 will be implemented and total at-risk program resources are 12 being reviewed. Assistance made available under the grant 13 program shall supplement district intervention, remediation 14 and enrichment programs and shall at minimum, be made available to students requiring additional instruction to 15 statewide content and performance standards 16 master 17 prescribed by the state board of education under W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii) or otherwise seeking credit recovery for 18 promotion to the subsequent grade level. Summer school 19 20 programs eligible for assistance under this section shall 21 also:

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23 (ii) Provide a minimum of sixty (60)

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7 programs providing enrichment instruction to students and before-school, after-school and Saturday school enhanced 8 9 instruction for student mastery of the state content and 10 performance standards are eligible for assistance under 11 section. These Before-school, after-school and 12 Saturday school programs for student mastery of state 13 standards shall augment amounts within the education 14 resource block grant model for addressing at-risk student needs over a transitional period during which full cost-15 16 based funding will be implemented and total at-risk program 17 resources are being reviewed. To receive eligibility under this subsection, a district shall file 18 program plans with the department of education requesting 19 20 use of a portion of summer school program funds otherwise 21 available under this section, not to exceed a maximum level 22 established by rule and regulation of the department. Plans submitted to the department shall be filed within the 23 24 time specifications imposed upon the applicant district for

1 summer school grants and shall be subject to program

2 requirements and criteria established by the department.

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4 (c) To receive grant assistance under this section, a 5 district shall apply to the department of education on or before April 15, 2006, and by April 15, 2007, for the 2007 6 7 summer school session and the 2007-2008 school year, as applicable. Application review by the department shall be 8 9 completed by May 1, 2006 of the appropriate year. On or before May 1, 2006, and May 1, 2007, as applicable, 10 11 districts shall be notified by the department of any 12 estimated grant amount to be made available to the district 13 during the 2006 appropriate summer school session and 14 school year.
