A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to cities and towns; prohibiting finalizing
- 2 of planning and zoning in annexed area until final reading
- 3 of annexation ordinance; providing for agreements on access
- 4 to water or sewer services to be petitions for annexation
- 5 or waivers of objection to annexation; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-1-403 by creating new subsections
- 11 (e) and (f), 15-1-410(a) and 15-7-602 by creating a new
- 12 subsection (d) are amended to read:

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- 14 15-1-403. Annexing territories; initiation of
- 15 proceedings; by landowners' petition; validity of
- 16 signatures; determinations.

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1 (e) If the clerk has certified compliance in
2 accordance with this section, the city or town may accept
3 and act on platting and zoning requests concerning the
4 territory petitioning for annexation. Platting or zoning
5 in the annexed area shall not be finalized until the
6 annexation ordinance has been approved on final reading by

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the governing body.

9 (f) Agreements which provide for access to a city or 10 town owned water or sewer services to property outside the city or town's corporate limits may be conditioned to serve 11 12 as a petition by the landowner for annexation under this 13 section and may serve as a waiver by the landowner of any 14 objection to an annexation for the property subject to the 15 agreement. The agreement may be filed as a petition either 16 by the landowner or by the city or town. The area subject 17 to annexation based in any manner on such an agreement 18 shall be required to meet the provisions of W.S. 19 15-1-402(a) and the procedures of this section, except that 20 the signatures provided on the agreement are not subject to 21 the time limitations of subsection (b) of this section. 22 Any agreement subject to a condition to serve as a petition for or waiver to objections to annexation shall be recorded 23 24 with the county clerk and the terms and conditions of the

1 agreement shall run with the property and be binding upon

2 the heirs, successors and assigns of the landowners

3 entering into the agreement.

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5 15-1-410. Annexing territories; extension of laws and 6 rights; extension of public utility service.

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(a) The territory and inhabitants of any annexed area 8 9 subject to all the laws, ordinances, rules and are 10 regulations of the city or town to which they are annexed 11 and are entitled to all the rights, privileges 12 franchises or other services afforded the inhabitants 13 thereof. The services shall be provided in accordance with the timetable provided pursuant to W.S. 15-1-402(c)(iii). 14 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no law, 15 16 ordinance, rule or regulation of a municipality annexing 17 property under W.S. 15-1-404 or pursuant to an agreement treated as a petition pursuant to W.S. 15-1-403(f) shall 18 19 restrict the continuous use of the property by a current or 20 subsequent owner of an interest in the property, if the use 21 was existing at any time within the year prior to the date 22 of annexation and was lawful at the time the property was annexed. For purposes of this subsection, a use which has 23 24 been discontinued for any one (1) year period after the

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date of annexation shall not be considered continuous and 1 2 shall not thereafter be reestablished unless in conformance 3 with current law, ordinance, rule or regulation. 4 5 15-7-602. Extension of system; outside corporate limits; rates; existing contracts; controversies; appeal. 6 7 (d) An agreement as provided in this section may be 8 9 conditioned to serve as a petition by the landowner for 10 annexation under W.S. 15-1-403(f) and may serve as a waiver 11 by the landowner to any objection to annexation of the 12 property as provided in W.S. 15-1-403(f). 13 14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2006. 15
