

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0006

Restaurant liquor licenses.

Sponsored by: Joint Corporations, Elections and Political  
Subdivisions Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; providing for  
2 restaurant liquor licenses as specified; regulating the  
3 sale of alcoholic beverages under a restaurant liquor  
4 license as specified; and providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-410(b) is amended to read:

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10 **12-4-410. Sale of alcoholic beverages for off-premises**  
11 **consumption prohibited; location, regulation and**  
12 **restrictions on dispensing of liquor; prohibiting certain**  
13 **activities.**

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15 (b) Alcoholic and malt beverages shall be dispensed  
16 and prepared for consumption in one (1) room upon the

1 licensed premises separated from the dining area in which  
2 alcoholic and malt beverages may be served and in the case  
3 of a golf course upon which a restaurant liquor license is  
4 operational or in the case of a guest ranch upon which a  
5 retail or restaurant liquor license is operational, at  
6 dispensing areas on the premises of the golf course or  
7 guest ranch as permitted by the licensing authority. No  
8 consumption of alcoholic or malt beverages shall be  
9 permitted within the dispensing room, nor shall any person  
10 other than employees over eighteen (18) years of age be  
11 permitted to enter the dispensing room. If a restaurant has  
12 a dispensing room separate from the dining area which is  
13 licensed prior to February 1, 1979 for purposes of  
14 alcoholic or malt beverage sales and consumption, the  
15 restaurant may dispense alcoholic or malt beverages in the  
16 separate dispensing room under a restaurant liquor license,  
17 and any person over eighteen (18) years of age is permitted  
18 to enter the separate dispensing room. A restaurant liquor  
19 licensee may provide for a separate dining or waiting area  
20 on the premises in which alcohol and malt beverages may be  
21 dispensed that is separate from the main dining area. The  
22 separate dining or waiting area in which alcohol and malt  
23 beverages are dispensed shall not be considered the  
24 dispensing room for purposes of the restaurant liquor

1 license, but the provisions of W.S. 12-5-203 shall apply to  
2 the separate dining or waiting area.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2006.
