1 AN ACT relating to the administration of the government;
2 amending duties of the select committee on developmental
3 programs as specified; requiring reports; providing an
4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** 2004 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 104,
9 Section 2(d) as amended by 2005 Wyoming Session Laws,
10 Chapter 168, Section 1 is amended to read:

12 **Section 2.**

14 (d) The select committee shall report to
15 the legislature and the governor not later than
16 October 1, 2004, on conclusions and
17 recommendations developed under subsection (c) of

1 this section, and shall further report to the
2 legislature and the governor not later than
3 October 1, 2005 on continued examination of
4 issues identified and the implementation status
5 of recommendations developed under subsection (c)
6 of this section. In addition, the committee
7 shall report to the legislature and the governor
8 not later than October 1, 2006 on:

9
10 (i) Adoption and implementation of
11 rules and regulations by the developmental
12 disabilities division;

13
14 (ii) Provider reimbursement methods
15 and service delivery in the adult, child and
16 acquired brain injury programs of the
17 developmental disabilities division;

18
19 (iii) Funding mechanisms in the
20 developmental preschool program of the
21 developmental disabilities division;

22
23 (iv) Other issues affecting
24 developmental disabilities.

2 **Section 2.** Seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000.00) is
3 appropriated from the general fund to the legislative
4 service office to fund the activities of the select
5 committee on developmental programs through December 31,
6 2006.

8 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
9 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
10 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
11 Constitution.
