- 14 defense.

1 (c) Any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years 2 who attempts in any manner to purchase alcoholic or malt 3 beverages or who falsifies any identification or uses any 4 false identification in order to obtain alcoholic or malt 5 beverages is guilty of a misdemeanor. If it has been 6 determined by the jury, or a judge in a nonjury trial, that 7 a motor vehicle was used by a minor to facilitate the offense, the judge may order a copy of the minor's record 8 9 of conviction under this subsection to be forwarded to the 10 department of transportation with a recommendation for 11 suspension of the minor's license or permit. The 12 department of transportation shall then suspend the minor's 13 driver's license or permit in accordance with W.S. 14 31-7-128(n). Any driver's license or permit suspension as a result of a conviction under this subsection shall not be 15 16 the basis for any increase in insurance premiums or the 17 cancellation of any insurance policy for a minor, his 18 parents or quardian.

1	(n) Upon receiving a record of the licensee's
2	conviction under W.S. 12-6-101(c) with a recommendation of
3	suspension by the court, the division shall suspend a
4	license or permit of the driver as follows:

7	offense of W.S. 12-6-101(c);
8	
9	(ii) For a period of six (6) months for a second
10	offense of W.S. 12-6-101(c);

12	(iii) For a period of one (1) year for a third
13	or any subsequent conviction of W.S. 12-6-101(c).
