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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-706 is created to read:

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12 **21-2-706.** Developmental preschool funding.

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- 14 (a) Expenditures by the division for developmental
- 15 preschool services shall be subject to the following:

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1 (i) Contractual payments to developmental 2 preschool service providers shall be sufficient for the 3 providers to provide adequate services for children age 4 birth through five (5) with developmental disabilities and 5 delays, including compensation levels for early childhood special educators, occupational therapists, physical 6 7 therapists and speech-language therapists that competitive with local school district compensation levels 8 9 for those categories; 10 11 (ii) Contractual payments to developmental 12 preschool service providers shall be sufficient for the 13 providers to pay for professional development activities of their professional employees and for a statewide program to 14 identify children in need of developmental preschool 15 16 services; 17 (iii) Contracts with developmental preschool 18 service providers shall require that the providers adopt 19 20 evidence-based best practices, as defined by the division 21 by rule and regulation. 22

(b) For purposes of calculating payments to service

- 1 division's standard budget for the subsequent biennium,

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(C) Whether services for children with 1 2 developmental disabilities are provided in a least 3 restrictive environment; 4 5 (D) Whether developmental preschools have adopted evidence-based best practices; 6 7 (E) Measurable standards adopted by the 8 9 division to ensure quality service delivery. 10 (ii) By October 1, 2006, regarding: 11 12 13 (A) The progress of a mental health pilot project and the cost of integrating mental health services 14 in developmental preschools; 15 16 17 (B) The capital construction needs of developmental preschools in the state. 18 19 20 Section 4. The department of education shall report 21 to the select committee on developmental programs or, if 22 that committee no longer exists, to the joint education interim committee by October 1, 2006 on the amount of funds 23 each school district is providing to the developmental 24

5 appropriated for developmental preschool programs, twelve

6 million dollars (\$12,000,000.00) is appropriated to the

11 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
