UW specialty license plates.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle license plates;
2 authorizing special University of Wyoming license plates;
3 specifying requirements; providing for termination of the
4 issuance and report of the termination as specified; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-219 is created to read:

11 **31-2-219. University of Wyoming license plates.**

13 (a) Any person required to register a vehicle in
14 Wyoming pursuant to W.S. 31-2-201 may apply to the
15 University of Wyoming alumni association for a statement of
16 eligibility for distinctive University of Wyoming license

1 plates for any motor vehicle owned by the applicant upon
2 registration of the vehicle. Upon payment by the applicant
3 of a fee, not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00),
4 assessed by the association, the association shall issue a
5 written statement of eligibility for University of Wyoming
6 license plates. Application shall be made at least thirty
7 (30) days before registration of the vehicle expires.

8

9 (b) The written statement of eligibility issued under
10 subsection (a) of this section shall be presented to the
11 department before University of Wyoming license plates may
12 be issued. License plates issued under this section shall
13 be displayed upon the vehicle for which they are issued.

14

15 (c) Except as provided in this section, application
16 for, issuance and renewal of University of Wyoming license
17 plates shall be subject to the same requirements and fees
18 as provided in this article. The fee required under W.S.
19 31-3-102(a)(viii) shall accompany each application.

20

21 (d) The department shall prescribe the design of the
22 special license plate authorized by this section, in
23 consultation with the University of Wyoming alumni
24 association, and arrange for production of the license

1 plates. Following initial approval, University of Wyoming
2 plates shall be subject to redesign on the same schedule as
3 nonspecialty license plates. The license plates shall be
4 issued by the county treasurer of each county.

5
6 (e) The department may prepare any special forms and
7 issue any rules and regulations necessary to carry out this
8 section.

9
10 (f) Unless one thousand (1,000) sets of license
11 plates are issued under this section before December 31,
12 2008, the plate authorized under this section shall be
13 eliminated from production and the department of
14 transportation shall report the cessation of production to
15 the legislature not later than January 15, 2009.

16
17 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2007.
