A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to medical malpractice insurance assistance
2 account; extending the deadline for applying for loans
3 under the account as specified; specifying applicability of
4 the act; providing an appropriation; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-1-902(j) and 35-1-903(e) are
10 amended to read:

11

12 **35-1-902. Medical malpractice insurance assistance**
13 **account; creation; duties of the department; requirements**
14 **for assistance; breach.**

16 (j) No loan shall be made under this section unless
17 the physician or contracting entity has completed and

1 submitted an application to the department on or before
2 ~~January 15, 2005~~ March 30, 2007.

4 **35-1-903. Assistance for risk retention group**
5 **participation; duties of the department; requirements for**
6 **assistance; breach.**

7
8 (e) No loan shall be made under this section unless
9 the physician has completed and submitted an application to
10 the department on or before ~~January 15, 2005~~ March 30,
11 2007.

12
13 **Section 2.** For the period beginning April 1, 2006 and
14 ending June 30, 2007, there is appropriated from the
15 general fund to the medical malpractice insurance account
16 six hundred eighty-two thousand five hundred dollars
17 (\$682,500.00) to implement the purposes of this act,
18 including loans for physicians' qualified medical
19 malpractice insurance premiums, loans for risk retention
20 group participation and administrative costs incurred by
21 the department of health in the implementation of W.S.
22 35-1-901 through 35-1-903.

1 **Section 3.** Loans under this act shall be made for
2 applications received by the department of health for the
3 period beginning April 1, 2006 and ending March 30, 2007.

5 **Section 4.** This act is effective April 1, 2006.
