For the period beginning April 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2007, there is appropriated from the 14 general fund to the medical malpractice insurance account 15 16 six hundred eighty-two thousand five hundred dollars 17 (\$682,500.00) to implement the purposes of this act, for physicians' qualified 18 including loans malpractice insurance premiums, loans for risk retention 19 20 group participation and administrative costs incurred by 21 the department of health in the implementation of W.S. 22 35-1-901 through 35-1-903.

Section 3. Loans under this act shall be made for applications received by the department of health for the period beginning April 1, 2006 and ending March 30, 2007.

Section 4. This act is effective April 1, 2006.
