Wyoming state hospital psychiatrists-recruitment.

## A BILL

## for

AN ACT relating to the department of health; authorizing 1 2 the Wyoming state hospital, with assistance from the office of rural health, to recruit and hire psychiatrists as 3 specified; authorizing educational loan forgiveness; 4 authorizing the office of rural health to administer the 5 loan forgiveness program; requiring rulemaking; conforming 6 a provision; providing an appropriation; and providing for 7 8 an effective date. 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10 11 Section 1. W.S. 9-2-125 is created to read: 12 13 9-2-125. Psychiatrist loan repayment program. 14 15

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(a) The Wyoming state hospital is authorized, with 1 2 assistance from the office of rural health, to hire and 3 enter into agreements with psychiatrists who have graduated 4 from accredited residency programs to provide health care 5 in this state. A psychiatrist hired under this section shall be an employee of the Wyoming state hospital. 6 The 7 agreement between the state hospital and the psychiatrist shall: 8

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10 (i) Provide for the psychiatrist to practice 11 psychiatric medicine in a community of the state as 12 directed by the state hospital. A psychiatrist shall agree 13 to provide psychiatric medical care for the period of the contract in underserved areas of the state to patients in 14 need of acute psychiatric care which the psychiatrist is 15 16 qualified to provide. The state hospital shall determine 17 which areas of the state are underserved;

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19 (ii) Provide that the psychiatrist shall be 20 repaid up to one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) of 21 the amount of outstanding educational loans the 22 psychiatrist has acquired after completing undergraduate 23 programs and as a direct result of medical school training

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in exchange for practicing his profession under the terms 1 2 of this section; 3 4 (iii) Require the psychiatrist to practice for a 5 minimum of four (4) years under the agreement; 6 7 (iv) Contain other provisions the state hospital deems necessary or appropriate to accomplish the purposes 8 9 of this section. 10 11 (b) The Wyoming state hospital shall promulgate rules 12 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. In 13 carrying out this section the state hospital shall assess health care needs of the state by geographic areas and 14 practice specialties and shall prioritize and enter into 15 agreements under this section accordingly. 16 17 18 Section 2. W.S. 9-2-117(a)(v) is amended to read: 19 20 9-2-117. Office of rural health care created; duties. 21 22 The office of rural health care is created within (a) the department of health. The office shall: 23 24

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1 (v) Administer the loan repayment programs 2 created by W.S. 9-2-118, and 9-2-119 and 9-2-125; 3 Section 3. 4 5 There is appropriated from the general fund to 6 (a) 7 the department of health for the biennium beginning July 1, 2006, three million two hundred fifty-five thousand dollars 8 9 (\$3,255,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, to 10 recruit, hire and pay salaries for not more than seven (7) 11 psychiatrists under this act, to be expended as follows: 12 13 (i) One hundred five thousand dollars (\$105,000.00) for recruitment and relocation expenses; 14 15 (ii) Two million four hundred fifty thousand 16 17 dollars (\$2,450,000.00) for salaries; and 18 19 hundred (iii) Seven thousand dollars 20 (\$700,000.00) for the educational loan forgiveness program 21 authorized by this act. 22 The department of health is authorized seven (7) 23 (b) 24 additional full-time equivalent positions to work as

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1	psychiatrists for the Wyoming state hospital under this
2	act.
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4	Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2006.
