A BILL

for

1	AN ACT relating to health care providers; removing the
2	requirement that the department of health, in administering
3	loan repayment programs for physicians, dentists and allied
4	health care providers, consult with the department advisory
5	council; requiring the department to consult with licensing
6	boards and professional associations, as specified;
7	removing a restriction on eligible physician and dentist
8	loans to post-undergraduate loans; authorizing loan
9	reimbursement for speech language pathologists; removing a
10	local matching funds requirement for allied health care
11	provider loan reimbursements; providing priority for
12	Wyoming graduates in loan reimbursement agreements;
13	providing appropriations; authorizing an additional
14	position; and providing for an effective date.

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9 (a) The department is authorized to enter into
10 agreements with physicians and dentists who have graduated
11 from accredited residency programs to provide health care

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14 (ii) Provide that the physician or dentist shall 15 be repaid up to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of 16 outstanding educational loans the physician or dentist has 17 acquired after completing undergraduate programs and as a direct result of medical or dental school training, not to 18 exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) per year, 19 20 including the matching funds specified in subsection (d) of 21 this section, in exchange for practicing his profession 22 under the terms of this section;

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1 (b) The department, in consultation with the 2 departmental advisory council appropriate licensing board 3 and professional association, shall promulgate 4 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. In 5 carrying out this section the department shall assess health care needs of the state by geographic areas and 6 7 practice specialties and shall prioritize and enter into agreements under this section accordingly. 8 9 10 9-2-119. Allied health care provider loan repayment 11 program. 12 13 (a) The department is authorized to enter into agreements with health care providers licensed or certified 14 to provide health care services in this state including, 15 16 but not limited to, hospital, medical, surgical, dental, 17 vision, nursing, radiology, mental health, speech language 18 pathology and pharmaceutical services. The agreements 19 shall: 20 21 (ii) Provide that the health care provider shall 22 be repaid up to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of outstanding educational loans the provider has acquired as 23 24 result of educational training directly related to

- 1 providing medical services, not to exceed ten thousand
- 2 dollars (\$10,000.00) per year, including the matching funds
- 3 specified in subsection (d) of this section, in exchange
- 4 for practicing under the terms of this section;

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- 6 (b) The department, in consultation with the
- 7 departmental advisory council appropriate licensing board
- 8 and professional association, shall promulgate rules
- 9 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. In
- 10 carrying out this section the department shall assess
- 11 health care needs of the state by geographic areas and
- 12 particular health care services required and shall
- 13 prioritize and enter into agreements under this section
- 14 accordingly.

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- 16 (e) In selecting health care providers for agreements
- 17 pursuant to this section, the department shall give
- 18 priority when practical to qualified graduates of the

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19 University of Wyoming or a Wyoming community college.
