1 AN ACT relating to school capital construction; modifying  
 2 required periodic maintenance of statewide building  
 3 condition assessment as specified; and providing for an  
 4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-15-115(b)(intro) and (c) is  
 9 amended to read:

11 **21-15-115. Statewide standards for school building**  
 12 **and facility adequacy; adequacy assessment.**

14 (b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section,  
 15 the commission shall maintain the comprehensive assessment  
 16 of the adequacy of existing school buildings and facilities  
 17 and of future space requirements within the state. ~~7~~ as

1 ~~established and existing within the department of education~~  
2 ~~on July 1, 2002, and as updated thereafter until the date~~  
3 ~~of transfer to the commission.~~ Maintenance of the  
4 assessment shall include district reporting of new  
5 construction and major building and facility repair and  
6 replacement activities ~~for the previous year~~ in accordance  
7 with guidelines prescribed by rule and regulation of the  
8 commission, the results of commission on-site visitations  
9 and inspections of buildings and facilities and needs  
10 assessment data and verification of building and facility  
11 ratings through periodic review. ~~as specified in this act.~~  
12 The assessment shall be designed and maintained to provide  
13 timely and uniform statewide data on all of the following:  
14

15 (c) The commission shall not less than once every  
16 four (4) years, review and evaluate the building and  
17 facility adequacy standards established under subsection  
18 (a) of this section. ~~and the assessment of building and~~  
19 ~~facility adequacy conducted under subsection (b) of this~~  
20 ~~section.~~ Review and evaluation of the standards shall  
21 include the identification of local enhancements to  
22 buildings and facilities during this review and evaluation  
23 period, and based upon criteria and procedures developed by  
24 the commission, a determination as to whether and how any

1 local enhancements should be incorporated into the  
2 statewide standards. Findings and recommendations pursuant  
3 to this subsection shall be reported to the select  
4 committee on school facilities before the next convening  
5 date of the legislative session immediately following  
6 completion of the review and evaluation, and shall  
7 specifically address any need to expand the needs  
8 assessment or to conduct a reassessment of building and  
9 facility adequacy.

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2006.
