## A BILL

for

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12 **39-15-105.** Exemptions.

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- 14 (a) The following sales or leases are exempt from the
- 15 excise tax imposed by this article:

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1 (viii) For the purpose of exempting sales of

2 services and tangible personal property as an economic

3 incentive, the following are exempt:

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5 (S) The sale of equipment used to construct clean coal technology, including those leading edge 6 7 technologies, in development but not currently used in this state as of March 1, 2007, or a commercial product whose 8 9 deployment in a coal combustion plant would allow for the 10 significant reduction of mercury, carbon dioxide and 11 criteria pollutants. As used in this subparagraph, "significant reduction" means the equipment shall advance 12 13 the environmental and efficiency performance beyond the 14 level of technologies that are in commercial service at 15 that facility. The exemption provided by this subparagraph shall be limited to the acquisition of equipment used in a 16 17 construction project to make it operational. The exemption 18 shall not apply to tools and other equipment used in 19 construction of a new facility, contracted services 20 for construction, or routine maintenance required 21 activities. This subparagraph is repealed effective June 22 30, 2015.

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9 The purchase of equipment used to (H) construct clean coal technology, including those leading 10 11 edge technologies, in development but not currently used in this state as of March 1, 2007, or a commercial product 12 13 whose deployment in a coal combustion plant would allow for 14 the significant reduction of mercury, carbon dioxide and 15 criteria pollutants. As used in this subparagraph, 16 "significant reduction" means the equipment shall advance 17 the environmental and efficiency performance beyond the level of technologies that are in commercial service at 18 19 that facility. The exemption provided by this subparagraph 20 shall be limited to the acquisition of equipment used in a 21 construction project to make it operational. The exemption 22 shall not apply to tools and other equipment used in 23 construction of a new facility, contracted services 24 required for construction, or routine maintenance

This subparagraph is repealed effective June 2 30, 2015. 3 4 Section 2. 5 (a) The Wyoming business council and the department 6 of revenue shall jointly report on or before November 1 of 7 each year to the joint minerals, business and economic 8 9 development interim committee. The report shall evaluate the cumulative effects of the exemption under this act from 10 11 initiation of the exemption and shall include: 12 13 (i) A history of employment in the clean coal 14 technology industry in terms of numbers of employees, fulltime and part-time employees and rate of turnover; 15 16 17 (ii) A history of wages and benefits disaggregated by gender for each job category; and 18 19 20 (iii) A history of taxes paid or owed to the

state of Wyoming by companies in the clean coal technology

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industry.

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1 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
