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- 14 (b) For the purpose of this subsection the term
- 15 "agencies" does not include the University of Wyoming,
- 16 community college districts, or school districts. It does

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1 not include the department of transportation except as to 2 paragraphs (xi), (xii) and (xiii) of this subsection. The 3 department through the general services division shall: 4 5 (iv) Adopt standard forms and procedures providing that bids or contracts for supplies or services 6 7 shall be awarded through the use of competitive sealed bidding, competitive negotiation, noncompetitive 8 negotiation or small purchase procedures as hereafter 9 10 provided: 11 12 (H) The director of the department of administration and information or his designee, upon a 13 14 written finding that it would be more efficient to use federal procurement procedures for contracts let by the 15 16 Wyoming military department concerning state owned 17 properties under the control of the adjutant general, may issue a waiver of procedures established pursuant to this 18 19 paragraph. 20 21 19-7-103. 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1 (b) The adjutant general of Wyoming shall have powers 2 and duties and be paid a salary as follows: 3 4 (xxi) He may use federal procurement procedures 5 when letting contracts concerning properties under the 6 control of the adjutant general, subject to receipt of a 7 waiver as provided in W.S. 9-2-1016(b)(iv)(H). 8 9 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007. 10
