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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-18-103(a)(i) and (ii), 11-18-105,

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13 11-18-103. Livestock board; powers generally.

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- 15 (a) In addition to powers and duties hereinafter
- 16 provided, the Wyoming livestock board may:

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2 (i) Appoint a state veterinarian who is a 3 graduate of a recognized veterinary college recognized by 4 the American Veterinary Medical Association and the Wyoming 5 state board of veterinary medicine and licensed to practice in Wyoming; , who shall be the chief executive officer of 6 7 the board; 8 9 (ii) And shall, in consultation with the state 10 veterinarian, appoint a director. The board, 11 consultation with the state veterinarian, may appoint deputy state veterinarians. The director and Any deputy 12

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state veterinarian:

(A) Deputy state veterinarians shall be graduates of a veterinary college recognized by the American Veterinary Medical Association and the Wyoming state board of veterinary medicine. Deputy state veterinarians shall serve at the pleasure of the state veterinarian. The state veterinarian shall supervise and control the action of the deputy state veterinarians and prescribe their duties and tenure of office.

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13 The expenses incurred in the conduct of the (b) 14 business of the Wyoming livestock board, the state veterinarian and its chief executive officer, including the 15 per diem of members of the board, the salaries or wages of 16 17 the chief executive officer, deputy state veterinarians and other necessary employees, traveling expenses, furnishing 18 19 of offices, stationery, supplies and all other expenditures 20 necessary and incident thereto, shall be paid out of the 21 general fund appropriations provided by law. All expenses 22 shall be itemized on the proper vouchers, approved by the chief executive officer, covered by proper receipts, and 23 24 paid by the state treasurer from money appropriated by law.

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2 11-18-110. Director; deputy directors; term; powers
3 and duties generally; orders subject to review.

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5 (a) The board shall appoint a director, who shall be the chief executive officer of the board. 6 The director shall serve at the pleasure of the chief executive officer 7 board and act as the secretary of the Wyoming livestock 8 9 board, subject to the rules and regulations of the board. 10 He may act for and perform the duties imposed by law upon 11 the board when the board is not in session, but an order or regulation made by him is subject to review, modification 12 13 or annulment by the board at any subsequent meeting.

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11-19-103. Quarantine of diseased animals generally; treatment thereof; effect of failure to obey order of state veterinarian.

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19 the state veterinarian finds (b) Whenever 20 infectious or contagious disease among domestic animals in 21 any section of the state he shall take such steps as will 22 prevent the spread of the disease. As a sanitary measure, he may inspect and compel the dipping, spraying or other 23 24 treatment of all such animals in Wyoming found to be

1 infected or exposed to the disease, under such rules and

2 regulations as he may adopt. Any order or regulation made

3 by the state veterinarian is subject to review,

4 modification or annulment by the board at any subsequent

5 meeting.

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7 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

9 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

10 Constitution.
