4 (i) Assists the sex offender in eluding a law 5 enforcement agency that is seeking to question the sex 6 offender about, or to arrest the sex offender for, his 7 noncompliance with the requirements of W.S. 7-19-302 or any 8 other law prohibiting a sexual offense, child abuse or 9 kidnapping;

(ii) Withholds information, including but not limited to the location of the sex offender, from, or fails to notify, the law enforcement agency about the sex offender's noncompliance with the requirements of W.S. 7-19-302 or any other law prohibiting a sexual offense, child abuse or kidnapping;

18 (iii) Harbors, or attempts to harbor, or assists 19 another person in harboring or attempting to harbor, the 20 sex offender;

(iv) Conceals or attempts to conceal, or assists another person in concealing or attempting to conceal, the sex offender; or

2 (v) Provides information to the law enforcement 3 agency regarding the sex offender which the person knows to 4 be false.

6 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply if 7 the sex offender is incarcerated in a local, state or 8 federal detention or correctional facility, or is in the 9 custody of a law enforcement agency.

11 (c) The penalty for a violation of subsection (a) of this section is the same penalty for the most serious crime 12 13 for which the sex offender who is being harbored is 14 charged, except if the person violating subsection (a) of this section is convicted for the first time of harboring a 15 16 sex offender who is charged with a second or subsequent 17 violation of W.S. 7-19-307, the person convicted under this 18 section shall only be subject to the penalty under W.S. 7-19-307(c). 19

21 Section 2. W.S. 7-19-307(c) and (d) is amended to 22 read:

2	(c) A person who knowingly fails to register as
3	required by W.S. 7-19-302 is guilty of a high misdemeanor
4	felony punishable by a fine of up to seven hundred fifty
5	dollars (\$750.00) one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00),
6	imprisonment for not more than <del>one (1) year <mark>five (5) years</mark>,</del>
7	or both.

9	(d) A person convicted of a subsequent violation of
10	knowingly failing to register as required by W.S. $7-19-302$
11	is guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of one thousand
12	dollars (\$1,000.00), imprisonment for not more than <del>five</del>
13	<del>(5) <u>ten</u> (10)</del> years, or both.
