A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to judicial salaries; increasing judicial  
2 salaries as specified; repealing a previous time limited  
3 additional compensation provision; amending an  
4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-1-110(a)(i) through (iii) is  
9 amended to read:

11 **5-1-110. Salaries of judges.**

13 (a) Subject to constitutional and statutory  
14 provisions concerning when salaries can become effective,  
15 judges of the supreme court, district courts and circuit  
16 courts shall receive the following annual salaries which

1 shall be paid in equal monthly installments on the last  
2 working day of the month:

4 (i) Supreme court justices shall receive an  
5 annual salary of ~~one hundred eight thousand two hundred~~  
6 ~~dollars (\$108,200.00) commencing July 1, 2004, and one~~  
7 ~~hundred eleven thousand four hundred dollars (\$111,400.00)~~  
8 ~~commencing July 1, 2005~~ one hundred nineteen thousand three  
9 hundred dollars (\$119,300.00) commencing July 1, 2007;

11 (ii) District court judges shall receive an  
12 annual salary of ~~one hundred three thousand dollars~~  
13 ~~(\$103,000.00) commencing July 1, 2004, and one hundred six~~  
14 ~~thousand one hundred dollars (\$106,100.00) commencing July~~  
15 ~~1, 2005~~ one hundred thirteen thousand six hundred dollars  
16 (\$113,600.00) commencing July 1, 2007;

18 (iii) Circuit court judges shall receive an  
19 annual salary of ~~eighty four thousand five hundred dollars~~  
20 ~~(\$84,500.00) commencing July 1, 2004, and eighty seven~~  
21 ~~thousand dollars (\$87,000.00) commencing July 1, 2005~~  
22 ninety-three thousand two hundred dollars (\$93,200.00)  
23 commencing July 1, 2007.
