A BILL

- 1 AN ACT relating to special districts; removing requirement
- 2 that no voters reside in an area in order to allow
- 3 enlargement without election; limiting taxing authority
- 4 when districts have not properly mapped boundaries; and
- 5 providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-29-301(a)(i) and 39-11-
- 10 102(c)(xxiv) are amended to read:

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22-29-301. Enlargement petitions.

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1 When the voters of an area wish to (a) 2 district, they may file an enlargement petition with the 3 county commissioners. If there are no voters within an area proposed to be included in a district, the landowners of 4 5 the area may file an enlargement petition with the county commissioners. Unless otherwise 6 provided under 7 subsection, the petition for enlargement shall include provisions allowing the board of district directors to be 8 enlarged by one (1) or more positions to be filled by 9 10 voters residing or located in the new area, the number of 11 positions to be determined by the petitioners and the 12 district directors of the existing district. Before the 13 petition is filed with the county commissioners, it shall 14 be approved by the directors of the affected district and by any other agency also required by the principal act to 15 approve the petition. The petition process shall 16 governed by W.S. 22-29-105 through 22-29-108. An election 17 18 need not be held on an enlargement petition if the petition 19 alleges and the county commissioners find:

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21 (i) All landowners within the new area and the

22 board of directors of the district agree to the inclusion

23 of the new area within the district.; and

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20 **Section 2.** W.S. 22-29-301(a)(ii) is repealed.

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22 *** Staff note: Repealing this provision is 23 problematic for the reasons stated in the accompanying 24 memo. Under the analysis in that memo, renters pay taxes 6

through increased rents and are entitled to vote under the equal protection clause of the constitution.

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2008.
