## A BILL

for

- 1 ANACT relating to school finance; establishing financial assistance program for instructional facilitators 2 and instructional coaches as a supplemental resource for 3 4 school district professional development programs; prescribing program application and program expenditures; 5 6 specifying computation of district payments; 7 duties and granting rulemaking authority to the department 8 of education; prescribing program reporting requirements; 9 and providing for an effective date. 10 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 12
- 13 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-335 is created to read:

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1 21-13-335. Supplemental financial assistance program

2 for instructional facilitators and instructional coaches.

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The supplemental financial assistance program for 4 instructional facilitators and instructional coaches 5 6 established to augment resources within the education resource block grant model available to districts for 7 professional development. Supplemental assistance under 8 9 section shall be for school-based instructional 10 facilitators and instructional coaches to assist schools 11 providing ongoing instructional with coaching and

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instructional mentoring.

14 (b) Each school district may apply to the department of education for financial assistance under this section on 15 or before April 15 of the school year immediately preceding 16 17 year for which financial the school assistance is 18 requested. Application shall be on a form and in a manner prescribed by the department and application review and 19 in accordance 20 selection shall be with the process established by department rule and regulation. At minimum, 21 22 the application shall include documentation of the 23 following program components:

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2 (i) Evidence of a research-based approach to

3 instructional facilitator program implementation;

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5 (ii) A plan for evaluation of the instructional

6 facilitator program over time.

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8 (c) The department shall notify each district of its

9 eligibility to participate in the financial assistance

10 program on or before May 1 of the school year preceding the

11 school year for which application is made, together with

12 any estimated amount to be made available to the district

13 for the applicable school year. The department shall

14 distribute assistance to each eligible district on or

15 before August 15 of the applicable school year for which

16 assistance is requested.

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18 (d) Financial assistance under this section shall be

19 based upon prior year school level attendance and

20 configuration reports submitted by each eligible school

21 district pursuant to W.S. 21-13-309(m)(iv). Grant amounts

22 shall be computed by the department for the eligible

23 applicant district as if the education resource block grant

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(f) Each district shall report to the department of education on expenditures of amounts distributed under this section together with additional information required by the department on instructional facilitation strategies employed by the district, the impact of facilitation on
