14 In addition to subsections (b) and (c) of this (g) section, the state superintendent shall for any district 15 21-13-102(b) as 16 subject to W.S. determined by the 17 department for any school year, provide payments from the school foundation program account in an amount equal to 18 one-third (1/3) of the foundation program amount computed 19 20 for that district for that school year in accordance with 21 W.S. 21-13-309. The computed amount shall be paid to each 22 eligible district on August 15 based upon tentative computations under W.S. 21-13-309, for which the department 23

1 program computations for the previous school year in the 2 manner provided under subsection (b) of this section. 3 amount computed under this subsection shall be reduced by 4 recapture revenues of a district which 5 limitations imposed under W.S. 21-13-102(c), as established by the department for that district for the prior school 6 7 year. Any district receiving a payment under subsection shall repay the foundation program account fifty 8 percent (50%) of the amount received on or before January 9 10 31 of the school year in which received, and shall repay the remaining fifty percent (50%) by June 15 of that school 11

Section 2. Nothing in this act is intended to be interpreted to modify the administration of school finance with respect to recapture payment schedules under W.S. 21-13-102(b) and recapture district entitlement loan repayment schedules under W.S. 21-13-313(g) for the 2007-2008 school year.
