W.S. 16-6-102(a) is amended to read: 8 9 16-6-102. Resident contractors; preference limitation 10 11 with reference to lowest bid or qualified response; decertification; denial of application for residency. 12 13 14 (a) If a contract is let by the state, any department thereof, or any county, city, town, school district, 15 community college district or other public corporation of 16 the state for the erection, construction, alteration or 17

1 repair of any public building, or other public structure, 2 or for making any addition thereto, or for any public work 3 improvements, the contract shall be let, if or 4 advertisement for bids or request for proposal is not 5 required, to a resident of the state. Unless an alternate design and construction delivery method is used, If 6 7 advertisement for bids or request for proposal is required 8 and the contract is less than five million dollars 9 (\$5,000,000.00), the contract shall be let to the 10 responsible certified resident making the lowest bid if the 11 certified resident's bid is not more than five percent (5%) higher than that of the lowest responsible nonresident 12 13 bidder. This subsection shall not apply to projects using 14 alternate design and delivery methods.
