4	(iii) "Entity" means any governmental unit,
5	special district, corporation, partnership or person which
6	will receive a legislative appropriation, directly or
7	indirectly, excluding the legislature, the judiciary and
8	the Wyoming department of transportation, game and fish
9	department except as provided in W.S. 23-1-502(d),
10	counties, municipalities and school districts;
11

15	(a) The department through the budget division shall:

17	(iii) Consult with each entity which will
18	require a legislative appropriation either directly or

7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this commission shall 8 section, the govern its financial 9 policies, subject to the written approval of its budgets by 10 the governor. The commission shall fix the budgets for the 11 operation and maintenance of the department and its 12 divisions for each fiscal year at its first stated meeting 13 of each fiscal year, and shall submit its budget estimates 14 for the following fiscal year as provided by W.S. 9-2-1012.

(d) The commission shall prepare a separate budget requesting general funds to implement and maintain its sensitive species and non game program and shall submit that budget for review, recommendation and approval as provided in W.S. 9-2-1010 through 9-2-1014.1. Any funds appropriated by the legislature which are specified for the this program shall be retained in a separate account, expended only for such management and notwithstanding any

1	other provision of law shall not be transferred or expended
2	for any other purpose. In managing for sensitive species
3	and non game programs the commission shall not be limited
4	to amounts appropriated by the legislature pursuant to this
5	subsection. The commission shall prepare a separate
6	accounting of the expenses incurred in each fiscal year for
7	the operation and maintenance of programs funded through
8	legislative appropriation and shall include the accounting
9	in its annual report.
