for

1 AN ACT relating to highways; increasing the fine for
2 willfully failing to observe a road closure; and providing
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 24-1-109 is amended to read:

9 **24-1-109. Closing or restricting use; failure to**
10 **observe signs and markers.**

12 Any person who willfully fails to observe any sign, marker,
13 warning, notice, or direction, placed or given under W.S.
14 24-1-108 is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction
15 thereof by any court of competent jurisdiction, shall be
16 subject to a fine of not more than ~~one hundred dollars~~

1 ~~(\$100.00)~~ seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) or to
2 imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days,
3 or to both such fine and imprisonment.

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
