3	(i) "Alien" means any person not a citizen or
4	national of the United States;

6	(ii) "Governmental entity" means any state
7	office, department, board, commission, institution or other
8	operating entity of the state including any city or town,
9	county, the University of Wyoming, community college

L2	(iii) "Secure and verifiable document" means a
L3	document issued by a state or federal jurisdiction or
L4	recognized by the United States government and that is
L5	verifiable by federal or state law enforcement,

3 assistance, unemployment benefit or other similar benefit

5 individual or household by a governmental entity or by

6 appropriated funds of a governmental entity, but does not

9 (A) Assistance for health care items and

10 services that are necessary for the treatment of an

11 emergency medical condition of the alien involved and are

12 not related to an organ transplant procedure;

14 (B) Short-term, noncash, in-kind emergency

15 disaster relief;

18 immunizations with respect to immunizable diseases and for

19 testing and treatment of symptoms of communicable diseases

21 state or local public benefit only to an individual who is

22 legally present in the United States and shall immediately

23 deny any benefit or benefit renewal upon determining that

24 an individual is unlawfully present in the United States.

benefit shall prove his identity with a secure 3

verifiable document before the benefit is awarded. 4
