1 A JOINT RESOLUTION urging Wyoming state agencies to replace

2 references to "mental retardation" in their documents with

3 a more respectful term or description that reflects

4 increased sensitivity to those who experience this

5 disability; and recommending Wyoming state agencies review

6 and consider language currently used by other states that

7 have previously changed their references.

9 WHEREAS, the stigma attached to the phrase "mental

10 retardation" creates an unwarranted burden on those who

11 experience this intellectual disability;

13 WHEREAS, in some cases government agencies inadvertently

14 perpetuate this burden by continuing to use this archaic

- 2 WHEREAS, this phrase should be changed to reflect a
- 3 sensitivity to those who experience this disability;

- 5 WHEREAS, many government agencies throughout the United
- 6 States have altered their documents to refer to these
- 7 individuals as persons with a disability;

- 9 WHEREAS, the use of the term "persons with a disability"
- 10 removes a measure of the sting and stigma by those who must
- 11 struggle with this disability every day of their lives; and

- 13 WHEREAS, Wyoming state agencies should take deliberate
- 14 steps to update their documents to reflect this more
- 15 sensitive reference to characterize those with this
- 16 disability.

- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 19 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

- 21 **Section 1.** That the Wyoming legislature urges Wyoming
- 22 state agencies to review their official documents and
- 23 replace current references to "mental retardation" with an

1 alternative that reflects increased sensitivity to those

2 who experience this disability.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Wyoming legislature

5 encourages Wyoming state agencies to review and consider

6 alternative references to this disability that are used by

7 other states.

9 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State transmit

10 copies of this resolution to the Wyoming governor's

11 planning council on developmental disabilities, the

12 department of health, the department of family services,

13 the early intervention council, and people first of

14 Wyoming.
