1 AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; repealing obsolete  
2 provisions relating to the interstate compact for the  
3 supervision of parolees and probationers; and providing for  
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-412 through 7-13-417 are  
9 repealed.

**\*\*\* STAFF COMMENTS \*\*\***

11 Some provisions of the Interstate Compact for  
12 Supervision of Parolees and Probationers has been  
13 in effect since as far back as 1939. In 2001  
14 Wyo. Sess. Laws, Chap. 71, the Legislature  
15 enacted the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender  
16 Supervision, which would become law effective  
17 July 1, 2001 or whenever ratified into law by at  
18 least 35 jurisdictions. Until Chapter 71 became

1 effective, the prior Compact would govern how the  
2 state should handle matters relating to the  
3 interstate supervision of parolees and  
4 probationers. On June 19, 2002, the 35<sup>th</sup>  
5 jurisdiction ratified the Interstate Compact for  
6 Adult Offender Supervision, thereby rendering the  
7 Interstate Compact for Supervision of Parolees  
8 and Probationers superfluous. This bill would  
9 repeal the prior Compact, since its provisions  
10 are no longer necessary and may cause confusion  
11 by their continued existence in statute.

13 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
16 Constitution.
