1 effective, the prior Compact would govern how the 2 should handle matters relating to the state 3 interstate supervision of parolees and  $35^{th}$ 4 probationers. On June 19, 2002, the 5 jurisdiction ratified the Interstate Compact for 6 Adult Offender Supervision, thereby rendering the 7 Interstate Compact for Supervision of Parolees 8 and Probationers superfluous. This bill would 9 repeal the prior Compact, since its provisions are no longer necessary and may cause confusion 10 11 by their continued existence in statute.
