Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming Constitution, Article 14, Section 6 is proposed for submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the next general election for approval or rejection to become valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority of the electors at the election:

## 8 Article 14, Section 6. Consolidation of offices.

10 (a) Whenever practicable the legislature may, and 11 whenever the same can be done without detriment to the public service, shall consolidate offices in state, county 12 13 and municipalities respectively, and whenever so 14 consolidated, the duties of such additional office shall be performed under an ex officio title. 15

(b) The legislature may establish through general law a procedure and laws governing the unification of counties and municipalities. A unified government shall be recognized under this constitution and the laws of the state as a county for purposes of taxation and revenues and as a municipality for purposes of Article 13 of this constitution.
