4 fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars

7 (b) A person who owns, manages, operates or otherwise

8 controls a public place where smoking is prohibited by W.S.

9 35-4-902 and who fails to comply with the provisions of

10 this article is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be

11 punished as follows:

13 (i) A fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for

14 the first violation;

16 (ii) A fine of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for

17 a second or subsequent violation.

21 The provisions of this article shall not prohibit adoption

22 of ordinances or regulations by counties or municipalities

23 that are more strict than the provisions of this article as

- 1 to places in which smoking is prohibited or as to the
- 2 penalty or remedy imposed for violation of an ordinance or
- 3 regulation prohibiting smoking in public places. Local
- 4 authorities shall have the express authority to enforce
- 5 local smoking prohibitions by action in their respective
- 6 local municipal courts.
