## A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to the clean coal task force; extending the existence of the clean coal task force as specified; requiring annual reports; authorizing funding of proposals from appropriations from abandoned mine land funds as specified; reappropriating funds to be used for clean coal research; providing an appropriation; and providing for an

7 effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-17-121 is created to read:

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1	(a) The clean coal research task force created								
2	pursuant to 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 186, Section								
3	2 shall exist until June 30, 2013 The task force shall								
4	consist of the voting members of the Wyoming energy								
5	resources council created pursuant to W.S. 21-17-117(e), or								
6	their designees.								
7									
8	(b) The task force shall meet at the call of the								
9	chairman. The task force shall issue requests for								
10	proposals for research projects into clean coal								
11	technologies. The task force shall review and evaluate								
12	proposals for research into clean coal technologies,								
13	subject to the following:								
14									
15	(i) Proposals may be received from academic								
16	institutions and private industry proponents;								
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18	(ii) Proposals shall be evaluated competitively								
19	on their probable benefits to the state of Wyoming and coal								

programs within this state;

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1	(iii)	Proposals	shall	enhance	and	improve	clear
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2 coal technologies with an emphasis on methods of combusting

3 sub-bituminous coal at high altitudes.

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5 (c) The task force shall issue a report to the

6 governor and the joint minerals, business and economic

7 development interim committee annually, no later than

8 September 30, including, but not limited to,

9 recommendations regarding funding specific proposals for

10 research into clean coal technologies in Wyoming.

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12 (d) The task force shall be staffed by the governor's

13 office with support from the University of Wyoming school

14 of energy resources. The task force may contract for

15 administrative and research services to aid in preparation

16 of the task force report.

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18 (e) Members of the task force who are not legislators

19 shall not receive a salary but shall receive reimbursement

20 for necessary travel and per diem expenses in the manner

21 and amount provided for state employees under W.S. 9-3-102

22 and 9-3-103. Members of the task force who are legislators

23 shall be paid salary, per diem and travel expenses as

- 1 provided in W.S. 28-5-101 for their official duties as
- 2 members of the task force.

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- 4 (f) The clean coal task force may award funds in the clean
- 5 coal technology account to proposals for clean coal after
- 6 submitting the task force's recommendations to the joint
- 7 minerals, business and economic development interim

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9 **Section 2.** W.S. 39-14-802(b) is amended to read:

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- 39-14-802. Clean coal research account created; funds
- 12 deposited; use of funds.

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- 14 (b) Deposits into the account created by subsection
- 15 (a) of this section shall only be expended upon
- 16 appropriation by the legislature pursuant to W.S.
- 17 21-17-117(f). Funds deposited in the account shall not be
- 18 expended until a dollar for dollar match has been provided
- 19 from nonstate funds. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008 or
- 20 9-4-207, unexpended funds shall not revert.

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- 22 Section 3. 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 48,
- 23 Section 320(a)(vii) is amended to read:

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Section 320.

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(a) No application to the federal office of surface mining for grants from the state of Wyoming's share of abandoned mine land funds from the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act Amendments of 2006, Section 411(h)(i), pursuant to 2007 H.R. 6111, shall be made except as expressly authorized by the legislature. legislature authorizes the department of environmental quality submit to applications to the federal office of surface mining for distribution of a portion of such funds for the period ending June 30, 2009, for the following projects:

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(vii) Three million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000.00) for clean coal technology research to be deposited into the account created under W.S. 39-14-802 to be expended pursuant to 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 186, Section 2(f) as created in Section

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4 (d) Funds appropriated under subsections (b) and (c)

5 of this section are appropriated. This appropriation shall

6 be for the period beginning with the effective date of this

7 act and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall

8 only be expended for the purpose of staffing the clean coal

9 task force and for expenses incurred by the clean coal task

10 force. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

11 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any

12 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

13 remaining from this appropriation shall not revert as

14 provided by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall

15 be included in the governor's and the legislative service

16 office's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget requests.

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18 **Section 6.** This act is effective immediately upon

19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

21 Constitution.
