5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-12-801(a), (e)(ii), by creating a
- 8 new paragraph (iii) and 9-12-802(a)(ii) are amended to
- 9 read:

- 11 9-12-801. Wyoming community facilities program;
- 12 purpose; creation; administration by council; rulemaking
- 13 authority; eligible projects.

2 (a) It is the purpose of this article to assist

3 communities to preserve former school and government

4 facilities that have existing or future community uses and

5 to assist communities in financing new community

6 facilities.

7

8 (e) In adopting rules and recommending grants and

9 loans under this article, the council shall require all

10 projects to be related to economic development or

11 enhancement of quality of life in a community. Projects

12 may consist of:

14 (ii) The purchase of an interest in or

15 cooperative agreements for the expansion, renovation or

16 conversion of school facilities to the extent the

17 facilities exceed statewide school building and facility

18 adequacy standards established by the school facilities

19 commission under W.S. 21-15-115. No ownership interest to

20 the project or facility under a project shall remain with

21 the school district upon expenditure of any funds under

22 this program for any project;

3	9-12-802. Community facility qualifications;
4	demonstration of need.

6	(a) To qualify for a grant or loan under this
7	article, an applicant shall demonstrate:
8	
9	(ii) A partnership or other working arrangement
10	or agreement with other local governmental entities or
11	private organizations or businesses to ensure the viability
12	of the project facility over a reasonable period of time;
13	[Staff Note: There may be a constitutional issue if the
14	political subdivision donates money to the private
15	organizations or businesses.]
16	
17	Section 2. There is appropriated ten million dollars
18	(\$10,000,000.00) from the general fund to the Wyoming
19	business council. This appropriation shall be for the
20	period beginning with the effective date of this act and
21	ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be
22	expended for the purpose of funding community facility
23	projects. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

- 1 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
- 2 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
- 3 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
- 4 by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation may be
- 5 included in the Wyoming business council's 2011-2012
- 6 standard biennial budget request.

8 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
