- 14 not be an adult citizen of the United States and a person
- 15 of good moral character. On and after July 1, 2009, no one
- 16 shall be examined unless he shall give satisfactory

evidence of having studied law at least three (3) years in 1 2 and graduated from a law school approved by the state board 3 of law examiners., or shall give satisfactory evidence of 4 having attended a law school as herein provided for a 5 period of at least one (1) year, and in addition thereto shall have studied law at least two (2) years in the office 6 7 of a member of the bar, or one (1) of the judges of this state, or shall give satisfactory evidence of having 8 9 attended a law school as herein provided for a period of 10 two (2) years, and in addition thereto shall have studied 11 law at least one (1) year in the office of a member of the bar, or one (1) of the judges of this state. Said study 12 13 must have been actually and not constructively commenced 14 and continued. 15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 16 17
