- 6 providing for a matching grant program; requiring a report;
- 7 providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective
- 8 date.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-10-106 is created to read:

13

14 37-10-106. Quiet zone program.

15

The commission shall administer a quiet zone 1 (a)

program, in conformity with the standards prescribed in 49 2

3 C.F.R. Part 222, for the establishment of quiet zones and

4 the installation of equipment to eliminate or minimize the

5 sounding of locomotive horns in populated areas.

6

Funds appropriated by the legislature for the 7

program created by this section shall be maintained in a 8

9 subaccount within the account established pursuant to W.S.

37-10-101 and shall be used only for the quiet zone 10

11 program, but may be combined with other state and federal

funds when quiet zone program components are included as 12

13 one of the devices to be installed in a grade crossing

improvement project. 14

16 (c) The commission shall establish a priority rating

17 system for the establishment of quiet zones and

installation of equipment at grade crossings, giving due 18

consideration to safety and other factors deemed relevant

by the commission. 20

22 (d) The commission shall establish through rule and

regulation a matching grant program for the distribution of 23

4 (i) The commission shall arrange the assessed

5 valuation of each county in descending order by county;

12 the list created in paragraph (i) of this subsection the

13 commission shall require a twenty-five percent (25%) match;

15 (B) For the middle eight (8) counties in

16 the list created in paragraph (i) of this subsection the

17 commission shall require a fifty percent (50%) match;

19 (C) For the top eight (8) counties in the

20 list created in paragraph (i) of this subsection the

21 commission shall require a seventy-five percent (75%)

(e) Except as provided in this section, expenditures 1

2 from the subaccount created by this section shall be

3 subject to the provisions of this chapter.

5 (f) Beginning October 1, 2010, the department of transportation shall annually report joint 6 to the and military affairs 7 transportation, highways interim committee by October 1 regarding the status 8 of the

9 equipment installation necessary to complete the quiet zone

program. 10

14 There is appropriated from the general fund to the transportation commission five hundred thousand dollars 15 (\$500,000.00) which shall be deposited in the subaccount 16 17 created by W.S. 37-10-106(b). The funds under this section shall be for the period beginning with the effective date 18 of this act and ending June 30, 2010. The funds under this 19 20 section shall only be expended for the purpose of the quiet 21 zone program established by this act. Notwithstanding any 22 other provision of law, the funds shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, 23

1	unobligated	funds	remaining	from	the	funds	under	this

2 section shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2010.

(b) The department of transportation shall include a 4

request for funds in its 2011-2012 exception budget request 5

to continue funding for the quiet zone program. 6

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 8
