12 **6-2-701.** Assisting suicide.

14 (a) A person who has knowledge that another person

15 intends to commit or attempt to commit suicide and who does

1 facilitating the suicide commits the offense of assisting 2 suicide: 3 4 (i) Provides the physical means by which the 5 other person attempts or commits suicide; 6 7 (ii) Participates in a physical act by which the other person attempts to commit or commits suicide. 8 9 10 (b) Assisting suicide is a felony punishable by 11 imprisonment in the penitentiary for not more than twenty (20) years. 12 13 14 (c) This section does not apply to: 15 16 (i) A licensed health care provider 17 administers, prescribes or dispenses medications procedures to relieve a person's pain or discomfort, even 18 19 if the medication or procedure may hasten or increase the 20 risk of death, unless the medications or procedures are 21 intended to cause death; 22 23 (ii) The withholding or withdrawing of medical 24 treatment or life-prolonging procedures by a licensed

health care provider, pursuant to but not limited to an advance health care directive under the Wyoming Health Care Decisions Act, a cardiopulmonary resuscitation directive authorized under W.S. 35-22-201 through 35-22-208, or a psychiatric advance directive authorized under W.S.
