AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; increasing the 1 taxation of cigarettes as provided; providing for the 2 distribution of the tax as specified; and providing for an 3 4 effective date. 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 Section 1. W.S. 39-18-104(a)(i), (ii), by creating a 8 9 new paragraph (iii), (b)(i), (ii) and by creating a new paragraph (iii) and 39-18-111 by creating a new subsection 10 11 (d) are amended to read: 12 39-18-104. Taxation rate. 13 14

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(a) There is levied and shall be collected and paid 1 2 to the department an excise tax upon the sale of each 3 cigarette sold by wholesalers as follows: 4 5 (i) Six-tenths of a cent (\$.006); and 6 (ii) Two and four-tenths cents (\$.024);- and 7 8 9 (iii) Two and five-tenths of a cent (\$0.025). 10 (b) There is levied and shall be paid to the 11 department an excise tax upon the use or storage by 12 consumers of cigarettes in Wyoming but only if the tax 13 imposed by subsection (a) of this section has not been paid 14 15 as follows: 16 17 (i) Six-tenths of a cent (\$.006); and 18 19 (ii) Two and four-tenths cents (\$.024);- and 20 21 (iii) Two and five-tenths of a cent (\$0.025). 22 39-18-111. Distribution. 23 24

1	(d) The revenue received from the tax imposed by W.S.
2	39-18-104(a)(iii) and (b)(iii) shall be distributed to
3	incorporated cities and towns and to boards of county
4	commissioners in the proportion the cigarette taxes derived
5	from sales within each incorporated city or town or county
6	bears to total cigarette taxes collected.

8	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
