1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; amending the definition
2 of an off-road recreational vehicle; and providing for an
3 effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xv)(K)(I) is amended to
8 read:

10 **31-1-101. Definitions.**

12 (a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this
13 act:

14

15 (xv) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which
16 is self-propelled except vehicles moved solely by human

1 power or motorized skateboards. The term includes the
2 following vehicles as hereafter defined:

4 (K) "Off-road recreational vehicle" means:

5
6 (I) A recreational vehicle primarily
7 designed for off-road use which is ~~fifty (50)~~ sixty (60)
8 inches or less in width, has an unladen weight of ~~nine~~
9 ~~hundred (900)~~ one thousand five hundred (1,500) pounds or
10 less, ~~and~~ is designed to be ridden astride upon a seat or
11 saddle, or is equipped with a bench or bucket seat, and is
12 designed to travel on at least three (3) low pressure
13 tires. A "low pressure tire" is a pneumatic tire at least
14 six (6) inches in width, designed for use on wheels with a
15 rim diameter of ~~twelve (12)~~ fourteen (14) inches or less
16 and having a manufacturer's recommended operating pressure
17 of ten (10) pounds per square inch or less;

19 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
