A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for reduced
2 price annual fishing licenses for residents at least
3 seventy-five years old; providing for recoupment of fees;
4 and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-504(a)(i) and 23-2-201 by
9 creating a new subsection (h) are amended to read:

10

11 **23-1-504. Free and reduced price license revenue**
12 **recoupment program.**

14 (a) Not later than July 31, 2007, and not later than
15 July 31 of each subsequent year thereafter, the chief
16 fiscal officer of the game and fish department shall

1 prepare and certify a report of licenses sold or issued in
2 the previous calendar year under the following statutes:

4 (i) W.S. 23-2-201(f), ~~and~~ (g) and (h);

5

6 **23-2-201. Fees; restrictions; verification of**
7 **residency required.**

8

9 (h) For a fee established by rule of the commission,
10 any resident who is at least seventy-five (75) years of age
11 prior to the issuance of the license may purchase an annual
12 resident fishing license. The fee established for a license
13 under this subsection shall be not more than sixty-five
14 percent (65%) nor less than sixty percent (60%) of the
15 resident fee, specified in paragraph (d)(i) of this
16 section.

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2010.
