district shall 1 (b) Each establish and maintain 2 minimum standards for the operation of school buses, 3 including: 4 5 (iv) Passengers in type A school buses equipped with factory installed lap belts shall wear a properly 6 secured lap or seat belt at all times the vehicle school 7 bus is in motion; as follows: 8 9 10 (A) In type A school buses equipped with 11 factory installed lap belts and ordered by a district prior to July 1, 2009, as evidenced by the date specified on the 12 13 district's purchase order or dealer's factory order; 14 (B) In all school buses ordered by a 15 district on or after July 1, 2009, as evidenced by the date 16 specified on the district's purchase order or dealer's 17 factory order, and equipped with a factory installed seat 18 19 belt assembly complying with federal motor vehicle safety standards adopted by the United States department of 20 21 transportation (49 C.F.R. Part 571, FMVSS no. 222). 22 (c) Evidence of a person's failure to wear a lap or 23 seat belt as required by paragraph (b) (iv) of this section, 24

(e)(f) All citations for violations of the motor 12 vehicle laws of this state and for violations of traffic 13 ordinances or traffic regulations of a local authority 14 shall contain a notation by the issuing officer indicating 15 whether the driver and passengers complied with this 16 17 section. Compliance with this section shall entitle a licensee to a ten dollar (\$10.00) reduction in the fine 18 otherwise imposed by any court having jurisdiction over the 19 20 alleged offense. The driver who violates this section may 21 be issued a citation and may be subject to a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). Any passenger who 22 violates this section may be issued a citation and may be 23

subject to a fine of not more than ten dollars (\$10.00).

2 (f)(q) Evidence of a person's failure to wear a 3 safety belt as required by this act shall not be admissible 4 in any civil action.

Section 2. The department of education shall notify 6 each school district of school bus seat belt assembly 7 requirements imposed under this act, and shall accordingly 8 9 modify school bus equipment standards promulgated under W.S. 21-13-320 within sufficient time for application to 10

school bus purchases and leases on or after July 1, 2009.
