- 15 systems from any gray wolf killed, sedated or found
- 16 deceased within Wyoming. The game and fish department is

2 determine the prevalence of brucella abortus among the wolf

3 population in Wyoming.

5 (b) The game and fish commission is authorized to 6 negotiate an agreement with the United States fish and 7 wildlife service that will facilitate the collection of 8 samples from wolves in Wyoming required under subsection

11 (c) There is appropriated forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) from the general fund to the game and fish 12 13 commission. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the effective date of this act and ending 14 June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended 15 for the purpose of funding the sample collection, testing 16 17 and study required under subsection (a) of this section. Notwithstanding any other provision 18 of law, appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 19 20 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated 21 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall not be 22 included in the commission's 2011-2012 standard biennial 23 24 budget request.
