- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 31-7-108(a) and 31-7-111(b) by
- 10 creating a new paragraph (xi) are amended to read:

1 (a) No driver's license shall be issued to any person 2 who is under the age of seventeen (17) years, except as 3 provided in W.S. 31-7-110 and 31-7-117(c), or unless the 4 person is at least sixteen (16) years of age and has held 5 an intermediate permit pursuant to W.S. 31-7-110(g) or a similar permit from another jurisdiction for six (6) months 6 7 and has completed a drivers education course approved by the appropriate school district, or taught by a person 8 9 qualified as a driving instructor pursuant to W.S. 21-2-802(h), 10 evidenced as by a passing grade or 11 certificate. Regardless of any other qualification to 12 receive a license, except persons holding a restricted 13 license under W.S. 31-7-117(c), no person shall receive a 14 class I or I2 driver's license pursuant to W.S. 15 31-7-110(a), (b) or (g) unless such person presents at the 16 time of application: 17 18 (i) A diploma or other certificate of high 19 school graduation or a general education development 20 certificate issued to the person in this state or any other 21 state; or
