AN ACT relating to insurance coverage; specifying the level 1 of benefits required for continuance of coverage under a 2 new plan by a succeeding carrier; and providing for an 3 4 effective date. 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 26-19-203(a)(ii)(A) is amended to 8 9 read: 10 11 26-19-203. Continuance of coverage where 1 carrier's contract replaces a plan of similar benefits of another 12 carrier. 13 14

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In those instances in which one (1) carrier's 1 (a) 2 contract replaces a plan of similar benefits of another 3 carrier: 4 5 (ii) The succeeding carrier is liable under the following circumstances: 6 7 (A) Each person covered under the prior 8 9 carrier's plan shall be eligible for complete coverage in accordance with the succeeding carrier's plan of benefits, 10 11 which shall include coverage for ninety (90) days for any complications caused as a result of a condition for which 12 13 benefits were paid under the prior plan within ninety (90) days prior to termination of that plan. Copayment and 14 deductible levels for coverage required under this 15 subparagraph may be reduced to the levels provided by the 16 17 succeeding carrier's plan; 18 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 19
