A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to junk dealers; prohibiting junk dealers
2 from purchasing or possessing beer kegs as specified;
3 amending archaic language; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-18-107 is created to read:

9

10 **33-18-107. Beer kegs.**

11

12 No junk dealer shall knowingly purchase or possess on any
13 premises which the junk dealer uses to buy, sell, store,
14 shred, melt, cut or otherwise alter scrap metal, a metal
15 beer keg or any recognizable part of a metal beer keg,

1 including a beer keg made of stainless steel, whether the
2 beer keg is damaged or not damaged.

4 **Section 2.** W.S. 33-18-106 is amended to read:

5

6 **33-18-106. Penalty; power of cities and towns not**
7 **impaired.**

9 Every junk dealer who shall be found guilty of a violation
10 of the provisions of this act shall, for the first offense,
11 be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00), nor more
12 than two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or imprisoned in the
13 county jail not more than sixty (60) days, ~~or either~~ or
14 both, in the discretion of the court, and for each
15 subsequent offense of violating any of the provisions of
16 this act of which any such junk dealer shall be found
17 guilty, such junk dealer shall be fined not less than one
18 hundred dollars (\$100.00), nor more than three hundred
19 dollars (\$300.00), or imprisoned in the county jail not
20 less than thirty (30) days nor more than ninety (90) days,
21 ~~or either~~ or both, in the discretion of the court;
22 provided, that this act shall not be construed to in any
23 ~~wise~~ way impair the power of cities or incorporated towns
24 in this state to license, tax and regulate any person,

1 persons or corporations now engaged in or hereafter
2 engaging in the buying and selling of second hand metals.

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
