8 Section 1. W.S. 33-18-102 is amended to read:

- 33-18-102. Records; book to be kept; limitation on
- 11 cash sales of metal property.

- 13 (a) Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the
- 14 junk business as defined in W.S. 33-18-101, shall keep a
- 15 book, in which shall be written in ink, at the time of each
- 16 and every sale, an accurate account and description, in the

1	English language, of all junk metal or rubber goods
2	purchased or sold, and the name and residence of the person
3	selling or buying the same. No entry in such book shall be
4	erased, mutilated or changed.

6	(b) In addition to the book required under subsection
7	(a) of this section, each junk dealer shall create and keep
8	for not less than two (2) years a written or electronic
9	record for each purchase or trade of:
10	
11	(i) Copper, brass or bronze in any form;
12	
13	(ii) Aluminum wire, cable, pipe, bar, ingot, rod
14	fitting or fastener; or
15	
16	(iii) Material containing copper or aluminum
17	which is used for farming purposes.

19	(c) Each record required under subsection (b) of this
20	section shall include:

22	(i) The name and address of the person
23	delivering the metal property to the junk dealer including
24	a copy of a current, valid photo identification;

2	(ii) The date of the transaction;
3	
4	(iii) The weight, quantity or volume of metal
5	property involved in the transaction and a general
6	description of the property;
7	
8	(iv) The amount paid for the property; and
9	
10	(v) The license plate number and description of
11	the vehicle used to deliver the property.

13	(d) No junk dealer shall pay more than two hundred
14	fifty dollars (\$250.00) in cash for any metal product as
15	specified in subsection (b) of this section and purchases
16	of those products for more than two hundred fifty dollars
17	(\$250.00) shall be made by check or other recordable means.
18	
19	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
