- 15 with the University of Wyoming for managing and maintaining
- 16 the database until the time it is appropriate to rebid this

hundred fourteen 7 (a) There is appropriated two thousand dollars (\$214,000.00) from the general fund to the 8 9 department of health. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) of this 6 appropriation shall be expended to design and implement a 7 user-friendly interface for the database authorized by 8 9 subsection (a) of this section to enable citizens and 10 policy makers to effectively use the 11 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 12 13 purpose other than the purposes of this subsection and any 14 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 15 This appropriation shall not be included in the 16 2010. 17 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.
