Liquor licenses-golf clubs.

Sponsored by: Representative(s) Stubson and Senator(s) Landen

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to liquor licenses; providing for issuance
2 of club limited liquor licenses to political subdivisions
3 for use at solely owned golf courses; providing for
4 issuance of club limited liquor licenses for use at golf
5 courses owned by political subdivisions in addition to
6 other licenses held by the political subdivision; allowing
7 subcontracting of golf club operation without transfer of
8 license; providing a definition; and providing for an
9 effective date.

11 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12

13 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-1-101(a)(iii) by creating a new
14 subparagraph (G), 12-4-103(b), 12-4-301 by creating a new
15 subsection (e) and 12-5-201(g) are amended to read:

1 **12-1-101. Definitions.**

3 (a) As used in this title:

4

5 (iii) "Club" means any of the following
6 organizations:

7

8 (G) A political subdivision of this state
9 owning, maintaining or operating a bona fide golf course
10 together with a clubhouse.

11

12 **12-4-103. Restrictions upon license or permit**
13 **applicants and holders; license limitation per person.**

14

15 (b) Except as provided in W.S. 12-4-301(e), no
16 licensing authority shall issue more than one (1) license
17 or permit to any one (1) person.

18

19 **12-4-301. Sales by clubs; license fees; petition;**
20 **license restrictions.**

21

22 (e) Notwithstanding W.S. 12-4-103(b), a political
23 subdivision of the state may hold a club limited retail
24 liquor license for each golf course owned, maintained or

1 operated by that political subdivision in addition to any
2 other license held by that political subdivision.

3

4 **12-5-201. Location, regulation and restrictions as to**
5 **place of sale; inspections; additional dispensing rooms.**

6

7 (g) Any golf club as defined by W.S.
8 12-1-101(a)(iii)(D) which holds a retail liquor license or
9 a club limited retail liquor license under W.S. 12-4-301
10 may dispense alcoholic beverages from any location within
11 the boundaries of the golf club premises. The premises
12 shall be a single property within a contiguous boundary
13 upon which the golf club is located and which shall be
14 identified in the license. Subsections (a) through (c) and
15 (e) of this section do not apply to golf clubs as defined
16 by W.S. 12-1-101(a)(iii)(D) which are holders of a retail
17 liquor license or a club limited retail liquor license with
18 respect to alcoholic beverages dispensed within the
19 contiguous boundaries of the golf club premises, except
20 that any location on the golf club premises where alcoholic
21 beverages are dispensed as approved by the licensing
22 authority shall comply with applicable sanitation and fire
23 hazard requirements and other applicable laws. The
24 licensing authority shall, as often as necessary, inspect

1 the licensed location where alcoholic beverages are
2 dispensed to ensure that the licensee is in compliance with
3 sanitation and fire hazard requirements. Any licensee
4 issued a club limited retail liquor license for use at a
5 bona fide golf course may contract for or otherwise
6 subcontract the operations of the golf course or any food
7 and beverage services associated therewith to another
8 individual or entity without transferring the license
9 thereto.

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
