A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crime victims; conditioning receipt of
2 funds by crime victim service providers on the provider's
3 agreement to submit an annual unduplicated count of the
4 number of victims served; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-40-118(e) and 9-1-638(a)(v) are
10 amended to read:

11

12 **1-40-118. Distribution of monies to crime victim**
13 **service and victim assistance providers.**

14

15 (e) In determining whether a victim service provider
16 is eligible to receive grants under subsection (d) of this

1 section, the primary consideration shall be whether the
2 eligibility requirements of the granting source are met,
3 including the provider's agreement to submit an annual
4 unduplicated count of the number of victims served in
5 accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the
6 division.

7

8 **9-1-638. Division of victim services; duties and**
9 **responsibilities.**

10

11 (a) The division of victim services shall:

12

13 (v) Establish minimum program standards and
14 uniform reporting procedures for community based services
15 and programs for victims supported by state funds and state
16 administered federal funds, including a requirement that
17 such community based services and providers submit an
18 annual unduplicated count of the number of victims served
19 in accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the
20 division;

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
