A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; exempting holders of
2 pioneer licenses from conservation stamp purchase
3 requirement; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-2-306(a)(intro) and by creating a
8 new subsection (c) is amended to read:

10 **23-2-306. Conservation stamp; exemptions.**

12 (a) Subject to ~~subsection~~ subsections (b) and (c) of
13 this section and the applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701,
14 each sportsman licensed under W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or
15 23-2-201 shall purchase a single conservation stamp for
16 twelve dollars (\$12.00) which shall be valid for one (1)

1 calendar year and the stamp or an authorization signifying
2 purchase of the stamp shall be in the possession of any
3 person exercising rights under any fishing or hunting
4 license issued pursuant to W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or
5 23-2-201. Holders of ~~licenses issued under W.S. 23-1-705(d)~~
6 ~~and (e), of~~ special limited fishing permits issued under
7 W.S. 23-2-207 and holders of licenses only under W.S.
8 23-2-101(j)(v) and (vi), 23-2-201(d)(vi) and (vii),
9 23-2-201(f) and 23-2-201(g) are exempt from the provisions
10 of this section when exercising hunting or fishing
11 privileges provided under those specific licenses. Revenues
12 collected from the sale of each stamp under this subsection
13 shall be deposited as follows:

15 (c) Holders of licenses issued under W.S. 23-1-705(d)
16 or (e) are exempt from the provisions of this section when
17 exercising any hunting or fishing privileges licensed under
18 this act. Licenses issued under W.S. 23-1-705(d) or (e)
19 shall be in possession of the person exempted under this
20 subsection when exercising any hunting or fishing privilege
21 licensed under this act.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2010.
