1 AN ACT relating to economic development; providing for 2 grants under the Wyoming business ready community program; 3 expanding projects available for funding; and providing for 4 an effective date. 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-12-601 by creating a new subsection 9 (j) and by renumbering (j) as (k) is amended to read: 10 11 9-12-601. Wyoming business ready community program; 12 purpose; creation; rulemaking. 13 (j) Grants may be made by the council for projects, 14 in accordance with rules of the council, which: 15 16

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1	(i) Improve the development of data generation
2	and information technology storage capabilities statewide
3	or in municipalities of the state;
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5	(ii) Encourage and provide for the expansion of
6	existing information technology enterprises in the state,
7	including those developed through the University of Wyoming
8	business technology center;
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10	(iii) Provide a reduction of the costs of
11	electrical power or bandwidth, or both, to businesses
12	meeting the provisions of paragraph (j)(i) or (ii) of this
13	section. In exchange for providing these reductions in
14	costs, the political subdivision receiving the grant and
15	providing the reduction in costs shall contract with the
16	business to receive direct benefits and indirect economic
17	development benefits including:
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19	(A) A specific amount of capital
20	investment by the business;
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22	(B) A specific minimum payroll
23	created by the business;
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1	(C) The provision of information
2	technology services to the state or the political
3	subdivision at a price discounted from the fair market
4	value of the services; and
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6	(D) An agreement to repay any funds
7	received to reduce costs if the business relocates from the
8	political subdivision prior to the expiration of five (5)
9	years from the date of first receiving funds.

13	(i) "Community development organization" means
14	as defined by W.S. 9-12-301(a)(ii);
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16	(ii) "State development organization" means as
17	defined by W.S. 9-12-301(a)(iv).
